

# TRAVEL TIPS

## BY CAR

---

Verify your carry permit has reciprocity for every state stopping in and final destination. (traveling through is protected by FOPA)

1. Firearm Owners Protection Act (FOPA) allows carry through (not staying in) any state, provided gun & ammo are out of reach /in trunk & locked in case.
  2. Each state/city have its own gun laws. Check with local police/gov website for ccw laws.
  3. if unsure, call local PD for clarity and ammo limits, if any.
  4. Keep valuables out of plain sight to prevent break in.
  5. Keep gun out of reach, literally means out of reach. Not glove box or console. Trunk is ideal.
- Advisable to print copy of gun laws/jurisdiction & copy of ccw permit (CYA insurance).

## BY AIR

---

Verify your carry permit has reciprocity in destination

Note: Pack in a larger bag

1. **VERIFY** with TSA and airline carrier on travel with firearm.
2. Verify you can carry at final destination, & if any limitations apply.
3. Hard sided lockable case.
  - Unloaded Firearm in case. Magazine and ammo can be in same case
4. TSA approved locks
5. Owner **KEEPS** keys
6. Declare travel with firearm at check in counter.
7. Q&A with Agent and sign form
8. Take bag to oversized baggage check in
